Certified Microbial Remediator (CMR)/Certified Microbial Remediation Supervisor (CMRS) Prep	Certified Residential Microbial Remediator (CRMR) Prep
<p>The Certified Microbial Remediator (CMR) and Certified Microbial Remediation Supervisor (CMRS) preparatory courses are concurrent 24-hour training classes designed to prepare potential candidates for achieving professional registrations from the American Council for Accredited Certification (ACAC) (formerly the American Indoor Air Quality Council, or AMIAQ) via their CMR & CMRS examinations.</p> <p>The objective of this course is to better familiarize workers and supervisors with a requisite understanding of work practices, protocols, rules, and industry standards for indoor microbial remediation.</p> <p>The course will review all industry publications which make up the required body of knowledge and cover all materials and topics to thoroughly prepare each participant for the examinations.
