<b>Construction in Healthcare (CH)</b>	<b>Certified Microbial Remediator (CMR)/Certified Microbial Remediation Supervisor (CMRS) Prep</b>	<b>Certified Residential Microbial Remediator (CRMR) Prep</b>
<p>Construction in Healthcare (CH) Training is a one-day (8-hour) training course designed to present the fundamentals of construction work performed within healthcare settings. The objective of this course is to better familiarize construction trade workers and supervisors with the multi-disciplined requirements in healthcare facilities. This will be accomplished through a review of the healthcare setting (principals, departments, objectives, and requirements), the basic applications of infection control, risk assessment practices, and specific healthcare construction techniques. Class presentations will include lectures, video presentations, interactive “hands-on” exercises, and resource handouts. A brief multiple-choice examination will be presented at the conclusion of the class, with successful examinees receiving a “Certificate of Achievement.”</p> <p><b>Tuition: \$200.</b></p>	<p>The Certified Microbial Remediator (CMR) and Certified Microbial Remediation Supervisor (CMRS) preparatory classes are concurrent 24-hour training classes designed to prepare potential candidates for achieving professional registrations from the American Council for Accredited Certification (ACAC) (formerly the American Indoor Air Quality Council, or AMIAQ) via their CMR &amp; CMRS examinations. The objective of these courses is to better familiarize workers and supervisors with a requisite understanding of work practices, protocols, rules, and industry standards for indoor microbial remediation. Class presentations will include lectures, video presentations, interactive “hands-on” exercises, and resource handouts.</p> <p><b>Tuition: \$650.</b></p>	<p>The Certified Residential Microbial Remediator (CRMR) preparatory class is a two-day (16-hour) training class design to prepare individuals pursuing the CRMR designation from the American Council for Accredited Certification (ACAC) (formerly the American Indoor Air Quality Council, or AMIAQ) via their in-house examinations. The CRMR prep class will introduce mold remediation concepts and approaches specific for the residential setting.</p> <p><b>Tuition: \$350</b></p>
